THE KRKA WATERFALLS NATIONAL PARK – PRIMOŠTEN

The Krka National Park is the second most visited national park in Croatia. It lies within the Šibenik-Knin County and covers a total area of 109 km² of the loveliest sections of the Krka River, and the lower course of the Čikola River. The national park is a vast and primarily unaltered area of exceptional natural value, including one or more preserved or insignificantly altered ecosystems. The purpose of the Park is primarily to serve science, culture, education and recreation, while tourism activities have also been introduced for its visitors. With its seven waterfalls and a total drop in altitude of 224 m, the Krka is a natural and karst phenomenon. The tufa waterfalls of the Krka River are the fundamental phenomenon of this river. We will start by touring the ethno-village inside the park and then take a 2-km wooden trail through pure nature. Once we reach the end of the wooden trail, we will take a 30-min boat ride to cross the river Krka and get to village of Skradin. There, the bus will wait for us to continue our journey to Primošten.

Primošten is small dalmatian gem that will win you over with its charm and leave lasting memories in your heart. One of the most striking symbols of Primošten is its old town, situated on a peninsula. This picturesque core is characterized by narrow stone streets, charming white stone houses, and flower-adorned balconies. The Church of St. George and its bell tower dominate the horizon, giving the town a unique character. Primošten is renowned for its beautiful beaches, famous for their cleanliness and crystal-clear waters. The beaches vary from pebbly to rocky, offering visitors various options for relaxation and sunbathing. The gastronomic scene in Primošten will satisfy even the most discerning foodies. Restaurants and taverns offer excellent Dalmatian cuisine, enhanced by fresh seafood, olive oil, and aromatic spices.

Important note: Take your swimsuits as you have 3 hours of free time in Primošten to enjoy swimming, diving, or sunbathing (in the case of a sunny weather).
